Bernice Macyk attended a virtual zoom Administrator's meeting on April 9, 2020.

- The Smoky Lake regional partners discussed the following Alberta Community Partnership (ACP) grants that were approved by Alberta Municipal Affairs:
  - Village of Waskatenau Project Titled: Infrastructure Assessment Study - \$200,000.00. Regional Partners are Village of Vilna, Smoky Lake County, Village of Waskatenau – managing partner.
  - Village of Vilna Project Titled: Stormwater Management Plan - \$200,000.00. Regional Partners are Smoky Lake County, Village of Waskatenau, Village of Vilna – managing partner.
  - Smoky Lake County Project Titled: Geographic Information System (GIS) – Infrastructure Data Integration -\$200,000.00. Regional Partners are Town of Smoky Lake, Village of Waskatenau, Village of Vilna, Smoky Lake County – managing partner.

Mayor Casey Caron and Bernice Macyk attended a virtual zoom meeting on April 21, 2020 with the Smoky Lake County to discuss the Old Waskatenau Nuisance grounds located at SE-16-59-19-W4th prior to the teleconference meeting with the Alberta Ministers later this day.

- The cost of the clean-up remediation is approx. \$200,000.00 which includes the soil sample testing after the clean-up.
- The Smoky Lake County inquired if the Village can contribute any funding towards the clean-up.
- The Village of Waskatenau can provide In-kind fill materials for the site.
- Once the site has been remediated consideration may be given to reduce the 300 metre setback which is hindering development within the Village and County.

Mayor Casey Caron and Bernice Macyk attended a Teleconference with the Smoky Lake County, Minister McIver – Alberta Transportation and Minister Panda – Alberta Infrastructure on April 21, 2020 to discuss the Waskatenau Old Nuisance Grounds remediation and funding of the project.

• Discussions regarding funding assistance from the Provincial Government for the project. The site used to be a Public Works yard owned by the Province prior to a nuisance grounds.

- Phase I and Phase II studies have been completed.
- Smoky Lake County presented an summary of the issue, negative impacts the old nuisance grounds is having on potential developments within the Village of Waskatenau and Smoky Lake County and potential sale of the said lands for a commercial development.
- The Minister's will review all the documents presented to them by the Smoky Lake County and will contact the County in the near future.

Smoky Lake Region EOC Bernice Macyk provided Council with an update on the activities for the Smoky Lake Region Emergency Operations Center (EOC).

- Monthly educational flyers to be mailed to residents/business through water bills or directly to mail boxes.
- North East Region EOC updates once per week for all Directors of Emergency Management and Assistants – Tuesdays at 10:30 am
- Provincial Operation Centre updates once per week on Tuesdays at 1:00 pm for Directors/Assistants as well.
- Ordered new sandbags for region for flooding. Old sandbags are in disrepair.
- Enforcement rules and regulations discussed with Sgt. Tina Chan.
- Social Distancing & Mass gatherings discussed at every meeting.
- Provincial Recovery Plans.
- Alberta Health Services regulations and guidelines links and Provincial and Federal Government links are providing valuable guideline tools for municipalities.
